

## Nazi Consul Loses <sup>News</sup> His Driver's License

NEWTON, Mass., Oct. 11—Herbert Scholz, German consul at Boston, said his lawyer would appear for him in District Court today to answer a parking violation charge that resulted in suspension of the consul's driving license. A report of the entire matter, he said, was sent yesterday to the German Embassy, but he added:

"I want to straighten the whole thing out. I'll co-operate in any way."

Mr. Scholz said the "funny thing" was that he hadn't driven his auto this year. His wife parked the car "apparently too close to the corner of a street," he said, Sept. 14.
