A resolution calling for the detailed motion picture and publishing

A resolution calling for the deportation or sterilization of all Jews was introduced at the covention of Gerald L. K. Smith America First Party in Detroit yesterday. Although the delegates, most of them elderly women, applauded it violently, Smith, who usually avoids the crasser of anti-Semitism, shoved it aside, though so deftly that most of the delegates weren't aware of what he was doing. They left convinced they had passed the resolution and talking of passing another calling for similar treatment of Negroes.

Sponsor of the sterilization proposal was Homer Maarts of Chicago, one-time Bundist. In side-tracking the Maerts resolution, Smith pressed on instead to passage of his own pet anti-Semitism resolution, one calling for an investigation of Jewish influence on Communism, on the New Deal, on

the motion picture and publishing industries, and on British-American relations, subjects on which the self-styled all-American rabblerouser sees eye to eye with Adolf Hitler.

In New York, the Firsters' action brought demands for Government investigation of them from the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League and the Friends of Democracy.
