NEW YORK, Dec. 28 Foolist Archer Zahne 56, described by the United States attorney's office as "one of the Nazis' ablest paid speakers and propagandists," yesterday was sentenced to a year and a day in prison on his recent plea of guilty to making false statements before an Army exclusion board.

Zahne, American-borh New York real estate operator, pleaded guilty to testifying falsely before the board that he was not a member of the Friends of New Germany, predecessor of the German-American Bund, and that he had not written a letter to A. Ammen von Borowsky, former officer in the United States Army Reserve, who had been excluded from the East Coast by Army authorities.
