Paper 'Cleaned Up' *5/14/42*

Accused of sedition last Thursday and ordered to show cause on May 14 why it should not be barred from the mails was the German-language newspaper *Herold*, of Philadelphia.

Harold Ambrose, executive assistant to Postmaster General Walker, announced yesterday that the May 2 issue of the *Herold* would be carried by the Postoffice Department. Ambrose said the department solicitor, Vincent M. Miles, had reviewed this issue and had found it much subdued and chastened. The seditious features previously noted, the solicitor ruled, have been cleaned out.

However, Miles emphasized that the May 14 hearing still would be held and that no future issue might be mailed until it was reviewed.
