Justice Bureau Asked to Delve

Into Dies' Record
The Department of Justice last night was asked to investigate Representative Dies (Democrat), Texas. chairman of the House Committee on Un-American Activities, on charges of "shielding" Axis agents.

The request was made by the Na-

tional Federation for Constitutional Liberties in a 52-page documented pamphlet outlining Dies' alleged activities. In a foreword, Federation Chairman George Marshall charges that "for four years Dies and his committee have, through a vigor-ous campaign of diversion and suppression, obscured the activities of the Nazi network, the Fifh Column

the Nazi network, the Fifh Column in the United States."

The document supported a message sent by Marshall earlier this month to William Power Maloney, special assistant to the Attorney General, who has been handling the special grand jury investigation into subversive activities.
