

EVERETT Wash.—The
Everett Central Labor council
has set up a committee
of three to investigate the
Hitlerite "Christian Commonwealth"
party, the "Black Legion of the Pa-
cific northwest."

Force of letters
The committee made its first re-
port to the last council meeting, and
after hearing it, the council voted to
contact affiliated local unions with
the request that they join in the
probe of the fascist group. *6/19/36*

The council is also asking the
city council to investigate the
Pelleyites, whom Representative
Dickstein of New York has ex-
posed as having a hand in the
formation of the Black Legion.
The "Christian Commonwealth"
party's program is almost identi-
cal with that of the Black Le-
gion.

The Central Labor council commit-
tee is expected to be expanded to in-
clude representatives of other unions
as a result of the council's recent
action.

The council has been a consistent
leader of anti-fascist actions in the
vicinity, participating in the Me-
Day parade and sending delegates
to the Second Northwest Congress
Against War and Fascism.
