Hold Secret Rally Here

RECORD Exposes Chicago Meeting Fascist Hits Unions

"Bullets—not ballots." That was the formula for a fascist coup in America, as advocated Saturday night by Roy Zachary, field marshal of the Silver Shirts Legion, at a secret meeting of his organization at Gross Park Hall, 2123 Roscoe St.

"They used bullets and not ballots in Germany,"

Zachary thundered to an audience of about 125 men and women. "They're using bullets and not ballots in Spain. And when the time comes, the Silver Legion will use bullets—not ballots—here."

The meeting was the third Silver Shirts gathering in Chicago in recent months addressed by Zachary, who has been on a tour trying to whip up membership for the openly fascist, anti-Semitic organization, which is headed by William Dudley Pelley. Zachary is Pelley's right-hand man.

At his previous appearance here, on May 8, Zachary, speaking before some 300 people at the Great Northern Hotel, threatened to assassinate President Roosevelt. This threat was exposed by the RECORD. The exposure, supported by sworn affidavits obtained by the American League for Peace and Democracy, was followed by an investigation of the Silver Shirts by government secret service agents under the U. S. Treasury Department.

WAXES BITTER

Zachary waxed bitter Saturday night against the RECORD, and denied that he had ever uttered the threat against the President's life. He also denounced Mrs. Jane Swanhuysen, organizational secretary of the American League for Peace and
