

ST. PAUL CONDEMNS SILVER SHIRTS

ST. PAUL, MINN. — The Silver Shirts, a reactionary Labor-hating secret organization now gaining headway in the State, was condemned in a resolution unanimously adopted at the Friday evening meeting of the St. Paul Trades and Labor Assembly. The resolution, while condemning all organizations which breed intolerance, particularly named the Silver Shirts as an organization established to break the trade union movement by any method at hand.

Following is the text of the resolution:

Whereas the enemies of Labor will attempt to break the trade union movement by any method and

Whereas this organization has connections with other organizations, such as Taylor's Finks, Local No. 1, which is opposed to all bonifide unionism, therefore be it

Resolved that the Trades and Labor Assembly go on record opposing with all our forces any and all organizations that have for their aim the smashing of the workers' movement and that we particularly, at this time, condemn the Silver Shirts which is attempting to pit race against race and is trying to create vigilante groups that will be used to break up workers' meetings and strikes.
