PROCEDURE OF IMPEACHMENT

WHEN Franklin Delano Roosevelt was inaugurated March 4th, 1933, and again on January 20th, 1937, he took the following oath or affirmation, as is required by the Constitution:

"I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will faithfully execute the office of president of the United States, and will to the best of my ability preserve, protect and defend the constitution of the United States."

Has the President violated his oath of office? We maintain that he has and we submit in another part of this issue an informal Bill of Particulars setting forth a partial list of acts which have violated either in spirit, or in fact, provisions of the Constitution of the United States.

In that same historic document, we find that even the highest public official, viz., the President of the United States, may be removed from office, and the procedure to be followed in cases of impeachment are succinctly set forth in the Constitution.

In these parlous times Christian Americans of sense, sanity and character should again renew their knowledge of the basic Law of the Land.

Despite the encroachments of the hordes of alien Jews upon our American institutions, and their usurpations and subversions in the field of Federal Government, we, the American people, do not have to supinely submit to the insolence and psychopathic insanities of these foreign elements.
