

**Canada Bans One U. S.  
Paper, Admits Another**

Ottawa, May 3 (AP).—The national revenue department tonight announced a ban on the entry into Canada of one publication and permission for another one, previously banned, to enter.

The announcement said the censors had barred from Canada the Cross and the Flag, a monthly magazine, published in English by Gerald L. K. Smith of Detroit.

It added that on recommendation of the censors, a Hungarian-language monthly, Nok Vilaga (Women's World), published by the National Committee of the Women's Federation, New York City, in future would be allowed to enter the Dominion.
