Intruder in Bomber

Plant Hides Identity

NEWARK, N. J., June 19 (C.T. P.S.).—G-men and Newark police today were questioning a seriously injured saboteur who was captured Monday night when a 10-ton steel door trapped him in the Aeronautical Corporation's plant at Newark Airport.

Near death from internal injuries and a possible fracture of the spine, the man said he was George Wyman, 28, and gave a Chicago address which proved to be a public park.

Inside the hangar, from which he was trying to escape when the door crushed him, are two new dive bombers awaiting test by the U. S. Navy.

The man refused to tell what he was doing at the plant.

Guards at the Brewster plant, which has heavy American and Allied plane orders, captured Wyman when they heard the motors of the heavy doors start to grind.
