

Vonsiatsky Waives Spy Charge Hearing

PROVIDENCE, June 9.—Anastase A. Vonsiatsky, Nazi-loving Russian Fascist, was sent back to Hartford, Conn., yesterday after waiving a hearing on a fugitive warrant charging him with espionage.

Vonsiatsky was turned over to U. S. Marshal Neale B. Murphy of Hartford after Federal Judge John B. Hartigan granted a petition for his transfer.

A Federal Grand Jury in Hartford has been investigating Vonsiatsky's activities since the FBI raided his home last month.
