

USO's Dirk Voss Held by FBI

Federal Bureau of Investigation activities yesterday resulted in:

¶ Announcement that Dirk Voss, who was revealed by PM as being active as a "captain" in the German-American section of the USO drive, is in custody as a "dangerous enemy alien."

¶ Denaturalization proceedings being filed against Friedrich Hackl, a printer who worked for the German Consulate, the Bund, the Christian Front and the Christian Mobilizers.

¶ A six-year sentence being imposed on Rudolph Keller, 25, a Swiss who admitted serving as an agent of the Italian Government and who photographed Gibraltar while a steward on a Swiss steamer.

¶ The arrest of John Hans Scophofen, 38, a German who was found taking photographs from the Lossberg Cliffs, in New Jersey, which overlook Hoboken and Manhattan. He said he "never took the trouble" to register as an alien. He had in his possession a list of nine U. S. sailors and soldiers whom he described to the FBI as "friends."
