

FBI Raiding Private Homes In Chicago

Act Without Warrants on Pretext of Seek- ing Communists

CHICAGO, Dec. 30.—Federal Bureau of Investigation agents and local "Red Squad" policemen are engaged in a series of illegal raids on private homes on the pretext that they are seeking Communist Party leaders.

No search warrants are used.

Attorney General Murphy's raiders burst into homes, frightening occupants.

Federal agents have also visited the Communist Party offices three times in recent weeks. No arrests have yet been made.

Murphy's violation of the Bill of Rights in these illegal raids is arousing sharp indignation in labor and progressive circles.

Workers are increasing their cash contributions to the Communist Party's defense fund and their loans to the bail fund.
