Westrick, who has been host to a number of important figures in American industry since arriving here four months ago, was direct-ed to surrender his auto license plates and prepare for a hearing whether he should retain his driver's permit. Dr. Westrick, well guarded in his W ald or f Astoria suite by Baroness Irmin-gard von Wagenheim, his secretary and relative by marriage of Ger-man Foreign Minister Joachim von Ribbentrop, had nothing to say.
