## Dr. Westrick Reported Banking \$5,000,000

Confidential Bulletin Says

Agent Brought Funds Here From Reich

Dr. Gerhard Alois Westrick, will o' wisp of the German Embassy, has \$5,000,000 socked away in a San Francisco bank, *The* Hour, confidential bulletin reported yester-

day.

The Hour was sure that the money was still in the San Francisco bank, but no one was quite certain where Dr. Westrick was at the moment. He was not present Friday when the State Motor Vehicle Bureau revoked his driving and registration licenses. Nor was he any place where a reporter might see him.

Since the New York Herald Tribune found him hiding in Scarsdale, Dr. Westrick, who came here to better commercial relations for Nazi Germany, has been doing all his bettering where no one could see him—least of all the press.
