Wife Sues Rev. Winrod for Separate Support

WICHITA, Kan., May 31—Under sheriff's protection, Mrs. Gerald Winrod took possession today of the Winrod home here after filing suit for separate maintenance from her husband, Rev. Gerald Winrod, who campaigned unsuccessfully in 1938 for the Republi-

can nomination for U. S. Senator from Kansas.

A temporary order providing sheriff's protection and provision for support of Mrs. Winrod and the couple's three children was granted ending settlement of the suit, which was filed yesterday.

Winrod, publisher of a religious magazine whose anti-Semitic and anti-Catholic articles created wide comment during his senatorial campaign, was charged with extreme cruelty and neglect.
