

X-Ray Magazine Banned From Mails

The initial phase of the Government's move to quiet "dirty little sheets" preaching sedition and aping the Axis propaganda line was closed today with the revocation of the second class mail privilege of a fourth weekly magazine. Postmaster General Frank C. Walker late yesterday revoked the second-class mail permit of the X-Ray, published at Muncie, Ind., by Court Asher. Previously, Social Justice, the German-language

Philadelphia Herold and Publicity, published at Wichita, Kan., by Elmer J. Garner, surrendered their permits by failing to appear at scheduled hearings.
