Canada to Arrest Fascist Leader And Associates

Montreal, (Thursday), May 30 (AP).
The Royal Canadian Mounted Police, acting under defense regulations, moved early today to serve warrants for the arrest of Adrien Arcand, head of the National Unity Party, and seven of his associates.

At an early hour, three members of the Fascist organization had been taken into custody.

Arcand was reported in the Laurentian Mountains.

At Toronto yesterday, Joseph Farr, party organizer, and John M. Lorimer, described by police as a member of the party, were arrested under defense regulations.
