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Andriano prw **Heads Drive For Funds**

SAN FRANCÍSCO, Oct. 25.-Sylvester Andriano, San Francisco Police Commissioner ap-pointed last Spring by Mayor Angelo J. Rossi, is\the "cover" Mussolini's fascist schools in California."

PARANTINI ADMITS

It was Parantini himself who revealed this to me when my questions to him about the school became too hot to handle. Parantini is a tall, blond, wasp-waisted fellow of about 35. He

waisted fellow of about 35. He wears a large fascist pin in which is mounted an expensive diamond —doubtless awarded for services rendered. He was nervous.

"Go and see Andriano," he said when I insisted on seeing a list of the teachers and the schools. "He is the Director of Dopo Scuola. He answers all questions." "Where can I find Andriano?" I asked. At the moment I could not believe it was Rossi's police commissioner. "At the Italian Consulate-on

"At the Italian Consulate—on the 7th floor at 550 Montgomery -0n street.'

He should have said "by" in-stead of "at" the Consulate. The doors are a few inches apart. . I finally faced Andriano across a large desk in his spacious office.

NOT REGISTERED

"You are Sylveste Andriano the Police Commissioner, appointed by Mayor Rossi not so long ago, aren't

you?" "Yes? What will you have?"

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Mr. Andriano impresses one as being a very able man. Unkind critics of Rossi, call Mr. Andriano 'the Mayor of San Francisco. "Are you a director of Dopo Scuola?"
