

Army Expels 5 On West Coast

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 10.—Five Italian-Americans; one of them chairman of a local draft board, have been expelled from the territory of the Western Defense Command.

They were expelled under Army procedure developed "for the exclusion under the dictates of military necessity of individuals deemed to be dangerous or potentially dangerous to military security. . ."

Under the expulsion order, they must leave the area "in the near future."

Three of the men are prominent in the San Francisco Italian community. The expelled men are:

¶ Sylvester Andriano, former San Francisco city supervisor and chairman of Local Draft Board 100.

¶ Ettore Patrizi, editor and publisher of *Daily Italia* and *Voce del Popolo*, Italian language newspapers.

¶ Renzel Turko, attorney.

¶ Sam Fusco and Remo Bosia.

Rumors that the Army intended to expel Andriano and Patrizi had circulated for several days, but officials refused comment until the expulsion orders were served today.
