

Plot Reported To Sabotage U. S. By Nazis in Mexico

Mexico City, Jan. 14 (AP).—Reliable sources asserted today President Lazaro Cardenas had ordered secret police to investigate reports that Nazi agents had established headquarters in Mexico City from which to conduct sabotage operations in the United States.

No arrests have been made, but government sources asserted Mexi-

can secret police had found evidence that German agents had been crossing the Mexican-United States frontier at frequent intervals in recent weeks.
