Otto Willumeit, former head of the German-American Bund in Chicago, who has pleaded guilty to a charge of conspiring to violate the 1917 Espionage Act, testified today before the special District grand jury investigating foreign propaganda activities in this country.

Willumeit, who was indicted in Hartford, Conn., was in custody of two deputy United States marshals.

Others who testified today were Joseph P. Kamp, New York City, and Dr. Donald McDaniels and John Winter, both of Chicago.
