## Jailed Spy Protests Freedom for Aides

NEW YORK, Sept. 17 (C.T. P.S.).—Still insisting she's no Nazi spy, red-haired Johanna Hofmann wants to know why she has served two years in a Federal prison while two men convicted with her are still out of jail from the Federal women's prison at Alderson, W. Va., she wrote her attorney here asking that he try to get her paroled and deported. What irks the former hairdresser on the North German Lloyd liner Europa the most, Attorney George C. Dix said, is that while she's serving time, Guenther Gustave Rumrich, army deserter, and Eric Glaser, former air corps private, are at liberty, pending appeal.
