The case of Frederick Reid, German consul attached to the German Consulate in New York is under consideration in the State Department. Sumner Welles, Acting Secretary of State, stated yesterday at his press conference.

The presence of Reid in this country has been protested by the Non-sectarian Anti-Nazi League and others, who charge that he came here from Brazil, where, it is alleged, he engaged in promoting Nazi activities. Welles declined to discuss the case further.
