Nazi Consul's **Recall Hinted By_Welles** T-14 8114140 Decision on Agent **Expelled by Brazil**

Expected Soon

Sumner Welles, Acting Secretary of State, indicated yesterday that Germany might soon be asked to recall Dr. Friedrich Ried, consul. in New York.

Welles said he planned an "early announcement" on the Ried case. This was interpreted to mean that the United States, following the principle of inter-American solidarity, would declare that Ried was objectionable here because his fifth-column activities had required his ouster from Brazil.

Came to U. S. in July

Ried, a six fotter with closely cropped iron-grey hair, was transferred to the United States in July, after serving as German consul in Rio Grande Do Sul for six years. The Brazilian government asked Berlin to remove him following a sharp personal quar-rel with a local police chief. Since the outbreak of the war last September, the German con-sulate in New York enjoyed a com-
