On September 20, 1940 Mr. Francisco A. Cárdenas, Post Office Box 266, Station A, San Antonio, Texas, submitted a registration statement in compliance with the provisions of the Act of June 8, 1938, as amended, requiring the registration of agents of foreign principals. In this statement he named as his foreign principals "Partido Revolucionario de Unificacion Nacional (Revolutionary Party of National Unification) of Mexico and General Juan Andreu Almazan, as legitimate President-elect of Mexico."

The acceptance and filing of a registration statement submitted by the agent of a foreign principal does not, of course imply agreement by the Department with the contents thereof. The Department finds, however, that this registration statement contains surplusage inimical to the foreign policy of the United States and has therefore cancelled it.
