

3 Men Seized in Mexico In Radio Seditious Case

Accused of Secret Broadcasts;
Linked to Sister of Cedillo

MEXICO CITY, Aug. 10 (AP).—Three men linked by Mexican government authorities to Higinia Cedillo, sister of Gen. Saturnino Cedillo, who led an abortive anti-Cardenas revolution in 1938 and subsequently was killed, were arrested today on charges of broadcasting seditious information from a secret station.

Police said Ruben Moreno Padres, leader of the Gold Shirts, also was detained, but they did not disclose any details.

The Gold Shirt organization long has been critical of President Lazaro Cardenas, who supported Gen. Manuel Avila Camacho in the July 7 Presidential election against the antiadministrationist, Gen. Juan Andrew Almazan.
