

Dying General Kept from Returning to His Home in Mexico

EL PASO, Tex., Aug. 5—Gen. Rodriguez, 42, who organized the Mexican gold shirts party after Mussolini's black shirts, was in a coma yesterday. His brother feared the end was not far. He has anemia and already has lived longer than physicians expected.

The General was expelled several years ago by presidential decree. Before he became critically ill, he told his brothers Joaquin and Manuel that to die in Mexico was his last wish.

When death became imminent yesterday he was placed in an ambulance. Joaquin and Manuel tried to take him to Juarez, his home. They were halted at the international bridge by Mexican immigration inspectors and told that Gen. Rodriguez could not enter Mexico until the decree was revoked.
