8 Accused Nazis Plead Not Guilty To Uruguay Plot

Montevideo, Uruguay, Sept. 23
(AP).—Eight alleged Nazi leaders pleaded not guilty tonight to charges of plotting against Uruguayan sovereignty and were committed to the city prison pending hearings.

Authorized sources said that the government would be obliged to expel Julio Dalldorf, press attache of the German legation, as the result of an investigation said to have disclosed that h has bn directing Nazi activities here.

These sources declared the German government would be asked to disavow Dalldorf's activities, and puish him.
