## Mexico Is Alarmed by German Influx

By Child Press MEXICO CITY, May 23--President Jacaro Cardenas today said any ele-ments, internal or foreign, attempting to endanger Mexico's "absolute neu-trality" will be dealt with strongly. His statement coincided with reports of an increase in the number of Ger-mans arriving in Mexico, resulting in a government investigation of possible "fifth column" activities. Cardenas told Mexican newspaper-men not to write anything that might further Mexico's enemies in any pos-sible effort to use Mexico as a base for subversive activities. Foreign sources here said 50 to 60 Germans have entered Mexico since the middle of April from Latin America and the United States. For addition, it was said, a much larger number of persons with German names but claiming citizenship in var-lose Central American countries, have been arriving.
