**Mexico Is Alarmed
by German Influx**

MEXICO CITY, May 23—President Lazaro Cardenas today said any elements, internal or foreign, attempting to endanger Mexico's "absolute neutrality" will be dealt with strongly.

His statement coincided with reports of an increase in the number of Germans arriving in Mexico, resulting in a government investigation of possible "fifth column" activities.

Cardenas told Mexican newspapermen not to write anything that might further Mexico's enemies in any possible effort to use Mexico as a base for subversive activities.

Foreign sources here said 50 to 60 Germans have entered Mexico since the middle of April from Latin America and the United States. In addition, it was said, a much larger number of persons with German names but claiming citizenship in various Central American countries, have been arriving.
