SUMMARY

1. Subject newspaper was found in the locker of [redacted] NAS Memphis, on 23 September 1970 by Command Authorities during an Administrative Inspection; newspaper relinquished to NISRA Memphis by source. Review of Subject newspaper disclosed it to be of an anti-establishment, racist oriented nature. This newspaper is the first issue to be published in Memphis and some of the members of the staff listed therein (civilians) are known to be "black power" advocates according to local intelligence agencies. The office of "We the People" is reflected in Subject newspaper as 1031 North Watkins #3, Memphis, Tenn., telephone 275-9150. Records of MATSS-902, NAS Memphis reflect that [redacted] in whose locker Subject newspaper was discovered, was transferred to [redacted] no additional identifying data on [redacted] was available locally.
