6. IT IS NOT ANTICIPATED THAT THE "INVADERS" WILL CREATE ANY FURTHER DISTURBANCES AT CARVER HIGH SCHOOL, 1591 PENNSYLVANIA Street, MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, FOR THE TIME BEING. THE INVADERS PLAN TO CREATE A DISTURBANCE AT EITHER BOOKER T. WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL, 715 SOUTH LAUDERDALE, MEMPHIS, OR AT HAMILTON HIGH SCHOOL, 1476 WILSON, MEMPHIS, (BOTH PREDOMINANTLY NEGRO SCHOOLS), EITHER ON 26 OR 24 MAY 1968.

7. RUMORS OF A DISTURBANCE HAVE BEEN CIRCULATING AMONG THE STUDENTS AT BOOKER T. WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL. THE SCHOOL STUDENTS ARE CALLING "GUARD", WHICH IS HEADED BY A MALL TEACHER AT THE SCHOOL, AND WHICH PERFORMS THE TASK OF KEEPING THE SCHOOL MALL FROM DISTURBANCES. THIS "GUARD" IS COMPOSED OF MALL STUDENTS WHO ARE OF SENIOR CLASS STANDING. HOWEVER, THE PRINCIPAL OF HAMILTON HIGH SCHOOL HAS INDICATED TO POLICE THAT THERE ARE NUMEROUS RUMORS AT HIS SCHOOL OF A DISTURBANCE BY THE STUDENTS. IT IS NOT ANTICIPATED THAT ANY DISTURBANCES WILL TAKE PLACE AT BOOKER T. WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL, BUT, THAT IF ANY OCCUR, IT WILL BE AT HAMILTON HIGH SCHOOL.
