Clapp affidavit- case we had, etc.

Allowing for lawyer exaggeration I believe this 2/1/72 letter from Clapp to Davis, who had gone over those of our records he wanted to, is a strong statement of the case Clapp saw, not a bargaining effort.

Davis had already told me they's not agree to a settlement I'd accept.

What was there to bargain over?

This means he had first gone over the records Taft and Williams had and then came to us. I d taken the others in to him.

It is hardly the representation of his affidavit.
