Dear Harold:

I enclose the following: (1) the Hoover phone logs for November 20-November 26, 1963 which Tony Summers obtained as a result of a FOIA lawsuit. I checked with him, and he said to give them to you. You will note that I was wrong about Billy Byars being the first phone call with Hoover after the assassination. Actually, as I read the logs, he was the third person Hoover called after the assassina-ation, Robert Kennedy (twice) and Rowley being the first two.

(2) the materials which Hoover sent to the White House on Warren commission critics, including you. I believe you got an earlier version of these. I don't know how much additional material has been released, if any. Mark Allen obtained these from the National Archives.

(3) a cable reporting that David Phillips, newly assigned chief of Cuba operations in Mexico City, was to spend two days at the JM WAVE station for consultation before arriving in Mexico City on October 9, 1963.

(4) CIA cable said to be dated 9/30/67 reporting that JM MOVE is the only "agency sponsored training camp."
