Dear Tom,

Thanks for your letter and the enclosures, which I've read. I annotated and highlighted the Federal Register thing in case anyone is up and we discuss it. I do not take time now for writing about and perhaps duplicating what is included that I do not understand and wasting time,

as I indicated when you were here, there is filing that is not as assassination records. I think what should be included is something like however classified and wherever of however located or stored.

One of my appeals identifies a Commission file other than 62-109090. Appeal ignored. 109090 is restricted to "liaison" with it.

As I told you, I believe that one of the most important kind of records is what the agencies did to and about all critics and criticism, as is in part illustrated by what I've sent.

Perhaps this may be more comprehensible in terms of what is very true but not well understood, that no actual investigation of the crime was made or ever intended. This did not have to be spelled out to any of the agencies and it does not rest on the Katzenbach records alone.

The FBI records as I told you include what is never searched, like the 94sat HQ and the 80s in the field offices.

Please tell Jerney that I have now the complete NEVER AGAIN! ms. as edited and re-edited, I've checked the Afterword, and no part that might be of help to you was cut. I did not check the rest. There was no time. I had to respond to source question in indicated pages and I did.
