
Dear Mr. Weisberg:

I am in receipt of your most recent series of letters and regret that you have not been satisfied with the performance of the Board and staff.

Significant effort has been devoted to sorting through and analyzing your previous correspondence to determine the most advantageous course to follow with regard to your many requests, comments, and suggestions, some of which lacked sufficient clarity for us to take action. My letter to you of March 9, 1995 was an effort to elicit necessary clarifications from you so that we could know more precisely what, if anything, we could do on your behalf.
