SUBJECT: Inaccuracies and Errors in Draft of [GPFLOOR] Report

1. I gathered from our conference in Mr. Helms' office on Tuesday 24 December 1963 that inaccuracies and policy errors were found in my draft of an initial report on the [GPFLOOR] case. This does not surprise me. Mr. Helms noted certain items he wanted changed or omitted and also instructed me to recheck the accuracy of the entire paper.

2. It would help me greatly if you would let me know what inaccuracies you found, if any, and what other changes you would recommend. As I understand it, my initial recommendation that the draft be considered nothing more than a working paper for those who prepare the final report was accepted by those present, and that the entire subject matter will be reworked anyway, incorporating the new material received from the FBI and elsewhere.

3. If you find it convenient, please mark your comments on your copy and lend it back to me. I will return it to you.
