Dear Mrs. Mason:

Your letter and its enclosure were received on February 15th.

During November, 1966, I was contacted by a newsman who requested any comments I cared to make regarding an alleged variance of the results of the medical examination of President Kennedy's body as recorded in FBI reports dated December 9, 1963, and January 13, 1964, and the official autopsy report.

In my reply to the newsman on November 23, 1966, I pointed out that the FBI, at the direction of President Johnson, conducted a prompt, intensive, objective and thorough investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy. The results of this investigation were accurately reported to the Warren Commission, and not one shred of evidence has been developed to link any other person in a conspiracy with Lee Harvey Oswald to assassinate President Kennedy. All available evidence and facts point to one conclusion--that Oswald acted alone in his crime.

I also made it clear in my reply to this inquiry from the newsman that I was speaking only for the FBI, not for any other agency or group involved in any phase of the inquiry into the assassination of President Kennedy.
