Memorandum for Mr. Johnson

Information furnished by FBI on LEE HARVEY OSWALD

1. August 1962 - interrogated by FBI after visit to Soviet Embassy in Washington. Declared that his purpose in visiting Embassy was solely to notify Embassy of his wife's whereabouts in the U.S. Denied having been given intelligence mission during his stay in the Soviet Union. Said he had gone to USSR for "personal reasons" and refused to expand. Daughter born in Soviet Union February 1962 and registered in Embassy, Moscow.

2. August 1963 - Arrested for breaking the peace in New Orleans apparently in connection with his distribution of "hands off Cuba" handbills. In interrogation following arrest admitted membership in New Orleans Committee for Fair Play for Cuba.

3. Received undesirable discharge from Marine Corps (date uncertain)

4. Reported to drink to excess and to be wife beater.

5. Present status: Arrested in connection with killing of Dallas policeman. No direct link with assassination. Reported to be refusing answer questions.
