Dr. A. A. Brandt has been publishing a group of articles in ~~CLICK~~, ~~PIC~~ and ~~LOOK~~. He also published an article in the June seventeenth issue of the ~~Toronto Star Weekly~~, Toronto, Ontario, Canada. The articles above referred to are reported to this office as having as their general subject "Bacterial Warfare". We are informed that the articles contain information which it is not in the national interest to publish. We also have been reliably informed that Dr. Brandt does lecturing, largely to womens clubs.
