I called Mr. Jamos J. Powley, Chief of the Secret Service, to offer our assistance. I advised Lir. Howley that our Dallas Office was already in contact with the Secret Service in Dallas and that we would render every possible assistance.

I mentioned that one of the fecret Fervice agents reportedly had been killed, and he stated he did not know this. I told him I had asked the name of the Secret Service Agent killed but it was not known.

I told Mr. Nowley that apparently the shooting came from the fourth floor of a building and shells had been found in the building; that these were Winchester shells - apparently a Winchester sille was used; and that the building was surrounded.

Mr. Rowley stuled he was also thinking of subversive elements - Afexico and Cuba. I then mentioned the Elan element. I advised Mr. Rowley that one witness stated he saw a Negro man loan out a window but later this was not confirmed and they do not know whether it was a white or a black.

I told Mr. Rowley the Furena would render every assistance. Mr. Rowley Indicated our assistence would be welcome and thanked mg. $EC 38 \quad C = 10.28 - 0.28$
