I called the Attorney General at his home and told him I thought we had the man who killed the President down in Dalias at the present time. I stated the rian's name is Lee Harvey Orwald; that he was working in the building from which the shots were fired that hit the Fresident and the Governor; that apparently he left the building and a block or two away ran into two police officers and, thinking they were going to arrest him, abot at them and killed one of them with a side arm; that the rifle had been left in the building.

I told the Attorner General that we have had a case on Oswald as he has been involved in the Fair Play for Cuba Committee. I sixted the Dallas police have him down at headquarters and I have bur Agents there.

The Attorney General asked if Oswald is a communist. I said that he is not a communist but has communist leanings. I related that Cawald went to Russia and stayed three years; came back to the United States in June, 1967, and went to Cuba on several occasions but would not tell us what he went to Cuba for. I stated he is a very mean-minded individual; that it is entirely possible be may have some communical sympathies but, so far as we know, is not a member of the Communical Parts.

I also informed the Attorney Ceneral that the plane has left with the President's body; that Lyndon Johnson has been sworn in and in coming in on the same plane.

I adviced him that I have told our men to go down to police headquarters and participate in the interrogation of Oswald.

I also advised him that we have received information that a woman notified police emborifies at Long Beach that she was told a few days ago that the Fresidest would be killed in Dalins by some man friend of here, when he arrived in Links today. I stated we are trying to find this woman and locate the men friend.
