Recently, while talking with an attorney in the Department of Justice on other matters, he mentioned that there was much dissatisfaction with Warren Olney in his position as head of the Administrative Office of the U. S. Courts. It appears that many of the old-time employees have left the agency and that Olney has brought in a lot of so-called experts that are making all kinds of surveys and are continually in the "hair" of many Federal Judges.
