[redacted] called me today and stated that Attorney General Brownell's office had just called him and indicated that Senator Langer of the Judiciary Committee had requested the summary reports on [redacted] Olney and [redacted]. The Senator is desirous of having these before 10:00 in the morning and he wondered if it would be possible to get these summaries. I told him that I believed it would be best if he contacted either Mr. Brownell or Mr. Rogers first; that the reports had already been sent to Mr. Brownell on [redacted] and Olney on January 15, January 19, and January 17, respectively. I told [redacted] that the request ~~for~~ for an investigation of [redacted] had only been received today. He then asked if we had summaries available on these three individuals and I told him that we did have extra copies. He stated he would check with Mr. Brownell or Mr. Rogers regarding Senator Langer's request and would call me back.
