

MILITARY SERVICE

The United States Marine Corps Officer records were reviewed by SE [REDACTED] and reflected that the appointee was appointed a First Lieutenant, United States Marine Corps Reserve, on November 4, 1942, to rank from October 28, 1942. The records reflect appointee accepted an appointment on November 24, 1942, and reported for active duty on December 16, 1942. The records further reflect appointee was detached on June 18, 1945, at San Francisco, California, and released from active duty on August 8, 1945, at which time his temporary appointment as a Captain, United States Marine Corps Reserve, automatically terminated, and he reverted to a First Lieutenant, United States Marine Corps Reserve. The records also reflect appointee accepted an appointment as a Captain, United States Marine Corps Reserve, on November 4, 1946, and an appointment as Major, United States Marine Corps Reserve, on January 16, 1950, and also accepted an appointment as a Lieutenant Colonel, United States Marine Corps Reserve, on October 9, 1952. The records reflect appointee has received efficiency ratings of very good through outstanding.

MISCELLANEOUS

The records of the Civil Service Commission, Investigations Division, were caused to be searched by SE [REDACTED] and no record concerning appointee was found.

The records of the House Committee on Un-American Activities were examined by SE [REDACTED] and were negative concerning appointee and his family.

The records of the Office of Naval Intelligence were caused to be searched by SE [REDACTED] and no record concerning appointee was found.

The Bureau has advised that a search of the Central Files of the FBI has been made and no information of a derogatory nature concerning loyalty which could be identified with the appointee was found.
