Good further reflection re FBI Exhibit 60 and closer study of the other shirt pictures with Leonard, including comparison of his pictures with mine, we have decided that first of all we'll see how his copies of the print Kleinblast did supply us came out. If any, he'll send one to each of you. If you then desire a clearer copy, I will have a best-possible, large negative made by my local camera shop and will supply the best-possible copies at a cost of about \$1.00 each. I intend special uses, as will be made clear, so I see no further distribution or disclosure of the best that Kleinblast shows signs of being able to deal a bad busting applied to the lead. (Signs only--no procedure need hard head)

As I carry this further, I'll be keeping you informed. To the extent I am entirely without doubt now of my original and unvarying analysis of both this wound and what it did the shirt.

However, between us we have discovered two major sleeve entries as yet unresolved and unexplained. One is probably innocent, if inexcusable carelessness. The other may be less innocent, but the result of carelessness.

Subject to Bud's agreement, I plan to carry this to the ultimate. I also think this provides still another means of still another stretching of the muscles of the FBI net.

If any of you can provide good evidence of the shirt, aside from FBI Exhibit 60, Ex 604 and FBI Exhibit 30 (composite), I'd appreciate copies, if possible with a note for Leonard, the would make his own print and return. I'm sorry, will keep it. But will give replace, or pay for replacement.
