Howard (Bud, Gary, Paul, Dick),

When on one day a Catholic peace-priest spends most of the day with me and Kleindienst sends me a letter and two pictures in an unfranked, unprinted envelope that comes through with neither stamps nor a cancellation nor postage due, I have to consider that I must continue my efforts to make a Christian out of the Deputy Attorney General.

My efforts are duly recorded in the enclosed letter to him, in response to his of today's receipt.

As you can see, the error is as we doped it out from the lithographic copy. The FBI printed the enlargement upside down. As I tried to tell Kleindienst, everything else he was told is also upside down. They even gave him an upside-down print for me.

I do not expect him to accept my offers, but I will promptly make good on my promises if he does. I think he will do himself a favor if he does, and it will not hurt us, either. Y'all can guess what evidence I have in mind, but the hints are that Paul should be well aware of one and Gary of the other. Each, in fact, knows of both. If I had the money I'd put in the DJ 118 forms on them, but the copying costs will exceed the minimum fees.

There is still no word on this from the Archives, but with Justice so willing to make the pictures available, I think Archives will find its explanations for refusing to unpersuasive except before a fixed or corrupt judge-especially with the existing error in the evidence, aside from the meaningless interpretation of said evidence.

I write this before going to bed. If copies are not enclosed, they will be in the next mailing, for I have to go into town relatively early.

The overall impression from the clearer pictures is that the hole is farther down than the testimony places it. In my letter I refer to the neckband, but it is probably a horizontal use of the cloth at the shoulders that shows in the picture, not the neckband, which is farther up.

I wish I had time to really study these pictures. That one of the tie in FBI 60 is, in some ways, much more informative than the one the Commission used. It says no bullet went by here even more clearly.

If anybody wants copies, I'll have them made.
