Enclosed are copies of the Mitchell letter, all I can scrounge up at the moment. My attorneys say that we have a very good chance of getting the information that I am after, which I have already told you about. They filed the complaint last week and now I suppose we will have to wait for the Government to respond which they feel should be within a month or so. I have had light press coverage and although most people are dubious about my chances, they all wish me the best.

This undertaking has been most expensive for me, the traveling, document copying and legal fees really mount up but even if we get an adverse decision, I feel that this particular aspect of the Assassination does need to be explored. What ever the outcome I will at least have made some contribution to the effort and what really hurts is that so few people really give a damn about the case or much else that the Establishment puts over on them.

Who is "GRS"? I got the other two.

Concerning the stuff in the Archives, the list and the material which will be contained in the 250 page batches that you spoke of. I would like to know which documents have been declassified in whole or in part since I got my copy of the WC Source Material List back in the Summer of 1968. I am interested in anything relating to the suspects involved in the shooting of JFK and Tippit, Oswald as an agent in the USSR or in the States and any of the CIA papers. Let me know what the cost is and I will send you a check.
